## Our target groups

We are pleased to be able to work with committed stakeholders at various levels. Here are a few examples:

### Agriculture with arable farming, animal husbandry, fruit, wine and vegetable growing as well as the food sector;

for example, in the EU project LIFE AgriAdapt, in which we provide agricultural information on climate change and sustainable climate change adaptation in a suitable manner.

### Municipalities, districts and authorities;

for example, in the Interreg project “Zukunftsrün”, in which we support cities and municipalities in preparing for the future using synergies between climate protection, climate change adaptation and biodiversity.

### Companies – regardless of the sector;

for example, in the project “Unternehmen Biologische Vielfalt” (UBI), in which we support companies in their commitment to biodiversity.

### Citizens;

for example, in the training of volunteers to become so called flowering ambassadors.

### Educational institutions and children’s and youth facilities;

for example, in the “Flower Kids” project, in which we offer sustainable education programs.

### Gardening and landscaping, energy consultants, solar installers and roofers;

for example, with the cross-trade training course on the construction of solar green roof combinations, which we are developing with partners as part of WEITER.mit.BILDUNG@BW.

### Energy cooperatives and municipal utilities;

for example, in the “SocialRES” project, in which we supported regional energy cooperatives across Europe in developing new business models and learning with and from each other.

## Our fields of action



### Energy Transition

**We advise various stakeholders on their contribution to the implementation of the energy transition.**

With focus on: Nature conservation in the energy transition, acceptance and participation, social innovation, technology promotion in the electricity and heat transition, resource management and climate protection.



## Nature and Water Conservation



**Experience, love and protect nature: We bring citizens closer to local nature and its diversity and show them how to conserve it with our projects.**

With focus on: Protecting lakes from micropollution, knowledge transfer in the international Living Lakes network, programs for sustainable education and concepts for nature-friendly recreational use of the forest.



## Agriculture & the Food Sector



**Together with partners from agriculture, the food sector and nature conservation, we launch initiatives and projects**

– for significantly more climate protection, biodiversity, better climate change adaptation and fair markets. All-round sustainable food systems are our goal.



## Business & Biodiversity

**Companies are dependent on biodiversity. At the same time, economic activities have a wide range of impacts on biodiversity.**

Together with the business community, we develop pragmatic approaches and engage in social debates on how the sustainable use and protection of biodiversity can succeed.



# What we have already achieved – a selection:

- Founding member of the “Living Lakes” network with currently 113 lakes worldwide
- Founding of the “Bioenergieregion Bodensee” as a milestone in the regional energy transition
- Promotion of more than 500 hectares of flowering areas for wild bees and other insects
- Supporting the semi-natural design of more than 100 company premises
- Advising 126 pilot farms on sustainable adaptation to climate change
- Climate protection advice for several hundred farms and cooperation with dairies that are committed to greater climate protection on their supplier farms
- Training 55 interested people as so called flowering ambassadors
- Renaturation or creation of 130 small bodies of water in the Lake Constance region

In total, we have implemented around **80 projects**

with a volume of around **40 Millionen** euros in our 30 years of existence
